


# SPORTING GREATS


**Ian Wright**


**Kadeena Cox MBE**

Kareena is a British parasport athlete. She was part of the 2015 IPC Athletics World Champs and the 2016 UCI Para-cycling Track World Champs, where she won world titles in the T37 100m and C4 500m time trials respectively.



**Daley Thompson CBE**

Thompson is a British former decathlete. He won the decathlon gold medal at the Olympic Games in 1980 and 1984, and broke the world record for the event four times.




**Serena Williams**

A former world No. 1, there's yet to be a barrier Williams hasn't been able to work towards and eventually smash. With 23 Grand Slam titles under her belt and an eye-watering 319 weeks as the world's best tennis player.



**Lennox Lewis CBE**

Lennox is a former professional boxer who competed from 1989 to 2003. He is a three-time world heavyweight champion, a two-time lineal champion, and remains the last heavyweight to hold the undisputed championship.




**Linford Christie OBE**

Linford is a Jamaican-born British former sprinter. He is the only British man to have won gold medals in the 100m at all four major competitions: the Olympics, the World Champs, the European Champs and the Commonwealth Games.



**Tessa Sanderson CBE**

Theresa Ione "Tessa" Sanderson, CBE is a British former javelin thrower and heptathlete. A six-time Olympian in the javelin from 1976 to 1996.



**Raheem Sterling MBE**

Raheem is an English professional footballer who plays as a winger and attacking midfielder for Premier League club Manchester City and the England national team.



**Christine Ohuruogu MBE**

Christine is a British athlete who specialised in the 400 metres, the event for which she is a former Olympic, World and Commonwealth Champion.



**Sir Mo Farah CBE**

Sir Mohamed Muktar Jama Farah CBE OLY is a Somali-born British long-distance runner and the most successful British track athlete in modern Olympic Games history.




**Marcus Rashford MBE**

Marcus is an English professional footballer who plays as a forward for Manchester United and the England national team. He is a campaigner against racism, homelessness and child hunger in the United Kingdom.



**Dame Kelly Holmes**

"I was 12 when I started and 34 before I achieved my dream, that should give people hope."



**Nicola Adams OBE**

Nicola became the first female boxer to become an Olympic champion after winning gold at London 2012, and the first double Olympic champion following a second gold medal at Rio 2016.



**Denise Lewis OBE**

Denise is a former heptathlete. She won the gold medal at the 2000 Sydney Olympics, was twice Commonwealth Games champion, was the 1998 European Champion and won World Championships silver medals in 1997 and 1999.



**Bukayo Saka**

Saka is an English professional footballer who plays as a left-winger or midfielder for Premier League club Arsenal and the England national team. Saka faced racist abuse online after missing a in the 2021 Euros final.



**Clive Sullivan**

A Great Britain and Wales winger, he played with both Hull and Hull Kingston Rovers, and also played for Oldham, and Doncaster. He was the first black captain of the Great Britain Lions and for any national British sporting side.
